

HOW TO CAST A WRITE-IN VOTE IN GEORGIA FOR JILL STEIN AND AJAMU BARAKA for president and vice president on Tues November 8, or at an early voting location near you.

It's easy. All precincts in Georgia use the same voting machines. Voters use a stylus to touch boxes on the screen. You touch a green button at the lower right corner of each screen to move to the following screen.

Here are the four simple steps to casting a ballot for Jill Stein and Ajamu Baraka. Don't let Georgia's unfair laws force you to vote your fears instead of your hopes.



STEP ONE

The candidates on the ballot for president of the United States, like those for every office on the voting machine are arranged in columns.

The bottom box on each column is "write in". To cast a write-in vote, use the stylus to touch "write-in" at the


bottom of the column. Then touch the green "next" button in the bottom right corner of the screen.



STEP TWO

A touch screen with keyboard pops up. Use the stylus to tap the letters spelling out the name of your presidential candidate in some form. "Jill Stein", "Dr. Jill Stein", or "Jill Stein and Ajamu Baraka" are all acceptable.

Election officials are required by law to overlook misspellings to discern the intent of the voter.



STEP THREE

When you're finished typing "Jill Stein" or "Dr. Jill Stein" or "Jill Stein and Ajamu Baraka" or something else clear and appropriate, use the stylus to tap "record write-in" at the bottom of the keyboard and you will be taken to the next screen.

STEP FOUR

You'll be taken back to the screen with the column of presidential candidates. But now "Jill Stein" will be at the bottom with a mark indicating your recorded write-in vote. Your write-in vote is done. Use the stylus to hit "next" and you have finished casting your write-in vote.

And don't forget to **VOTE NO ON AMENDMENT ONE**, the governor's so-called "Opportunity School District" measure to privatize public education in Georgia.

The Green Party is the only party that opposes privatization, especially school privatization, and which takes no money from charter school sugar daddies.
